**Saturday April 2:**

**10.30-11.30am:** photo the horse-drawn boat as it comes up the Diggle locks, then  
**1.00pm:** cheer the boat into the tunnel; join a 4 mile guided walk over the tunnel to Marsden to meet the boat being legged through the tunnel for about 3 hours.

**Sunday April 3:** from 1.00pm cheer three horseboats into the tunnel at Marsden, join a 4 mile guided walk over the tunnel from Marsden to Diggle to meet boats

**Monday April 4:** from 10.00am cheer three horseboats into the tunnel at Diggle, join a 4 mile guided walk over the tunnel from Diggle to Marsden to meet boats
